

Good Afternoon, this is Michael Kapfer, Assistant Principal of Longwood High School with a message for our rising seniors and their families. I hope this message finds you healthy and well. I wanted to provide an update on our senior parking application process for the 2020-2021 school year.

As per my last message, students and families will have the option to apply for senior parking online via a Google Form or fill out a paper application and bring it into the High School along with all other appropriate paperwork. If you choose to fill out a paper application, you can now download and print an application, complete with our discipline procedures contract, from our web page. **If you need a hard copy mailed to your home, please contact Roberta at 345-9205 as soon as possible.**

We will be open to receive your paper application only from **August 11 through August 13 from 8:30 a.m. until 12:00 noon. On Tuesday, August 11 – last names starting with “A” through “I” will be accepted. On Wednesday, August 12 – last names starting with “J” through “R” will be accepted. On Thursday, August 13 – last names starting with “S” through “Z” will be accepted. Parking assignments will be on a lottery basis and will be assigned starting the week of August 31.**

If you do not wish to come to the high school to apply, and would rather apply online via a Google Form, the link to that form will be posted in the coming weeks. I will send out another messenger when access to the online application is available.
