- **Live homework help** is available on-line, after 2:00 p.m., through the Longwood Public Library, at www.longwood.suffolk.lib.ny.us. You must have a valid library card number.

- **Homework help and tutoring assistance--Khan Academy**(<http://www.khanacademy.org/>) free, personalized tutoring with mini lessons, customized practice questions, and student progress data tracking.

- Longwood High School Students may sign-up for a **FREE** online ACT and SAT test preparation program, **Method Test Prep**, by logging onto the district website and clicking onto '*Student Resources*,' then clicking on '*SAT & ACT Review*.' Students then set up an individual account to reinforce their math, critical reading, writing, ACT and SAT test-taking skills.
